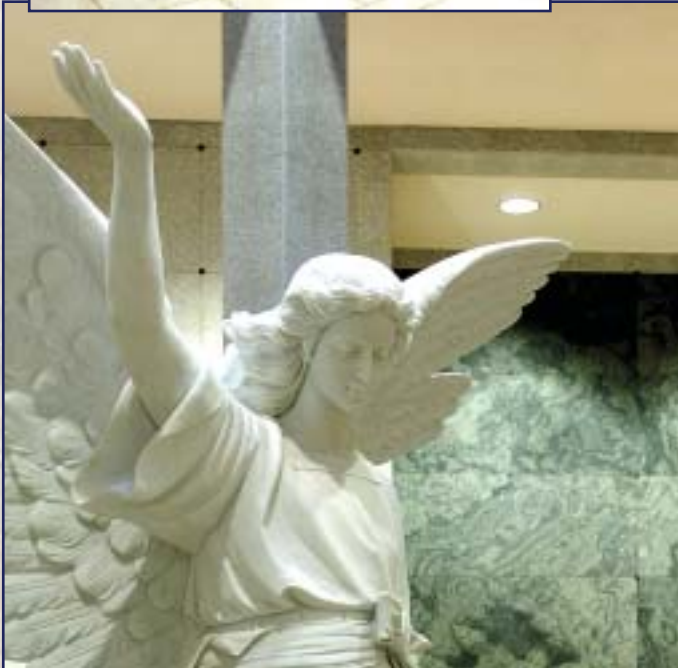




Windows, skylights and courtyards were incorporated into the design to provide visitors with natural light; arbors, trellises and plantings were included in the scope of work to beautify the courtyards. In one courtyard there is a fountain, and one area is centered around an eight-foot custom made angel carved in Italy.

The angel was inspired by the many marble statues found out on the grounds of The Woodlawn Cemetery.

## NOTICE TO ALL LOT OWNERS

We have just been notified by the New York City Department of Health:

**“Vases or other containers in cemeteries that hold water are a major source for mosquito reproduction and significantly increase the risk of transmission of West Nile Virus.”**

Because of this, we are being ordered by the NYC Department of Health to:

- **Remove all vases from the cemetery**
- **Fill all permanent vases or containers that can hold water with sand or soil**
- **Prohibit the use of all vases that can contain water in the cemetery until October 15**

Per this order, the Cemetery Maintenance Personnel has started to remove any vases that fall under this order. If you come to visit in the near future and a vase you had placed is not there, the Cemetery has removed it.
