Notice to all Lot Owners

The Department of Health for the City of New York has determined that vases and other containers in cemeteries provide a habitat for mosquito reproduction and increase the risk for West Nile Virus. Under Sections 17-145 and 17-148 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York, The Woodlawn Cemetery is required to remove flower pots, vases and any other containers during the peak months of mosquito activity - April 31 through October 31, 2005. During those months, Cemetery Maintenance Personnel will remove any vases or other containers from outdoor gravesites.
